## **Grant Application Form**

The Charity distributes small-medium sized grants (these typically range from £50 and in exceptional circumstances to £500) to help people who are in need, hardship or distress. There is no age qualification for a grant, but people receiving a grant **must** be resident in the "Ancient Parish of Eynsham" which covers all of the present Parish and most of Freeland also. However, there is a provision in the rules of the Charity which enables grants to be made in exceptional cases to people who are resident immediately outside the area of the Ancient Parish, so anyone living anywhere in Freeland should feel free to apply.

Trustees are **not** allowed to make grants directly to relieve rates, taxes or other public charges, nor can they commit themselves in advance to repeat any help they give. The Trustees do not make loans. The trustees do not usually consider repeated applications if they could be construed as day-to-day living costs.

The Trustees meet four times a year, usually in February, May, August or September and November. They will consider the application and be in touch with you as soon as possible. There is also a sub-committee to deal with urgent applications between meetings. All applications are treated absolutely confidentially.
