## COMMUNITY OWNED SOLAR PV

### **BIG PLANS from small beginnings**

GreenTEA is working with the Low Carbon Hub to scale up renewable power in our area.

Over the next 3 years the Hub plans to increase community owned renewable generation to 30mWh- **that will power about 10,000 homes and deliver over £15m in community benefit over its lifetime!**

But that's not all. We are very lucky to be working with the Low Carbon Hub on the **Eynsham Smart and Fair Futures** project for smart, clean energy in our area - read more in the **Project LEO** poster.

It began 10 years ago. There are three community owned solar PV installations in Eynsham. The largest is at the Village Hall with two others at St Peter's. Green TEA worked with the Low Carbon Hub to arrange these installations and some of the money generated helps to support our other energy work.



Since it was installed in 2012, the Village Hall array has generated about **106,500kWh**

**That's enough to power over 30 houses for a year!**
